DAY TRIP FOR 10-12 YEAR OLDS

Ever wished you were put in charge? Maybe of a surgery, performing a life-saving operation; or of a theatre, putting on a spectacular performance; or of a passenger plane, transporting people across the world...?

Kidzania is a 75,000 sq. ft. size city where you can be all of these things – it is not just ‘playing’ or ‘pretending’, but you actually get to learn how the controls of an aeroplane work, take part in a firefighting drill complete with fire engine;

or record your own music in the production studio. It’s not all just running around and trying on fake costumes, but you can pick from 60 different activities that will place you in a situation, with a group leader to teach you how professionals would deal with it, and then in no time at all you are playing the professionals’ roles yourself!

For the first time, Oxford Summer Courses are taking the Wycombe Abbey students for a day trip there and we are incredibly excited about it. Kidzania completely immerses the students in a whole different learning environment, where they gain practical skills and a sense of responsibility, while remaining completely safe, fun and engaging.

Their educational strategy aims to empower children and young people to take control over their own learning and to gain the confidence to try out completely new skills. It is all achieved through team work of small groups, which is a fantastic way to improve communication skills and emotional awareness.
